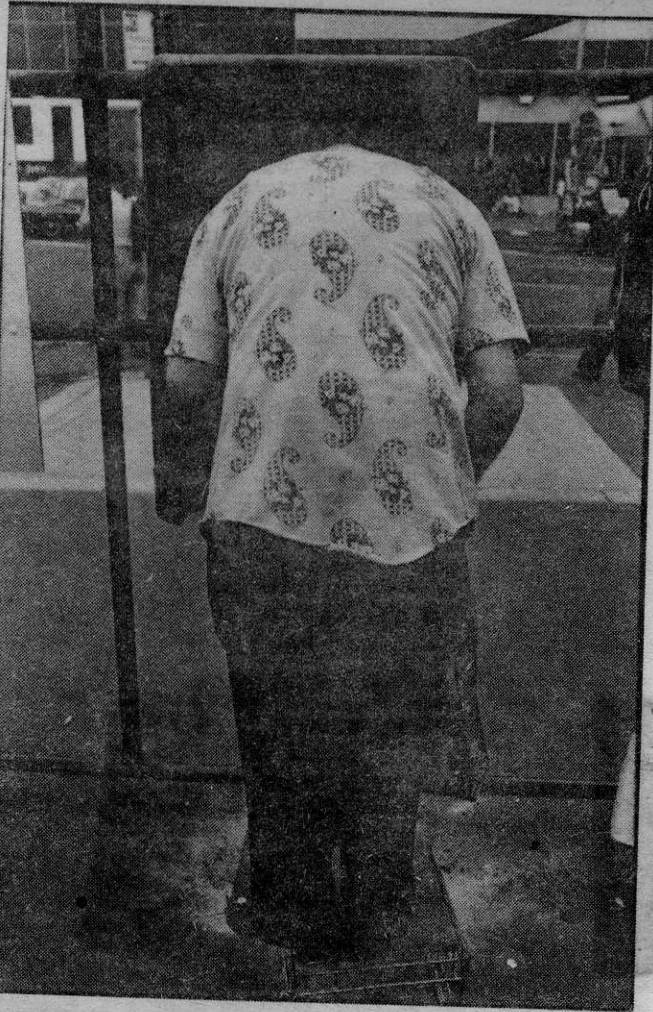

WELCOME TO NEW HAVEN

Look into these nine peep shows, turn the cranks, pull the levers: short poems about a romance float by; whimsical abstract tableaux—bits of plastic, tiny toys, metal scraps—show you where the couple loved and lost. New Haven defeats them, but the lover discovers that imagination and memory help you survive in cities. Sculptor Robert Taplin and poet Daniel Wolff originally scattered the boxes around New Haven; it took two and a half hours to do the cycle. You can do it in 15 minutes at the south end of Union Square. The audience reaction is part of the pleasure. Union Square Park, to October 6. (Lifson)
